

G1-M4-Topic B

G1-M4-L7: “Less than” & “Greater than” is important terminology in lesson 8. Prepare Ss for this, by incorporating it into the “1 more/less, 10 more/less” fluency activity, e.g. after Ss say “ $20 + 1 = 21$ ”, direct them to say “21 is greater than 20.” After they say, “ $31 - 1 = 30$ ”, “30 is less than 31.”

G1-M4-L8: Consider writing in options on the Problem Set, e.g. in 1a “20 is *greater than* *less than* 18” and have the Ss circle the correct answer.

G1-M4-L9: An additional application Problem prompt – Draw an arrow from one place value chart to the other. On top of the arrow, write the number sentence needed to arrive at the value of the other number sentence. Instead of having Ss write out their answer for part B, have them verbalize it to a neighbor.
